Taping Instructions
Spring Concert—Wednesday May 15, 2019



Instructions:

1. Use a good quality cassette tape, CD, digital audio recorder or smart phone. (Such as a Sony Digital Voice Recorder)
VIDEO IS NOT ACCEPTABLE!
2. Rewind recording to the beginning.
3. State your name and instrument at the beginning of the tape.
4. **Check to make sure the recorder is working properly.**
We will not make any exceptions for recordings that malfunction!
5. Record yourself playing the following pieces in the order listed below:

Cello:

Stand By Me (Start 2nd ending after 9)
Vanguard Overture
Pink Panther

Bass:

Modal Festival
Classic Rock
Vanguard Overture

Violin & Viola:

Fiddle and Stomp
Stand By Me (Start at 9)
Pink Panther

6. When you have recorded all four pieces, rewind the tape to the beginning. Any tape not rewound will not be heard and you will be placed at the back of your section.
7. Write your name clearly on the outside of the tape and the case.
8. **Tapes are due no later than: WEDNESDAY MAY 1, 2019**

Note: If you are absent, you need to send your tape to school with someone who can turn it in to us or have your parents leave it in the main office for Mr. Amendol.

If you do not have access to a tape recorder, you will need to see Mr. Amendol or Mr. Monaco to sign out a recorder.
